European Union Enhancements to Aviation Security

As you may be aware, the European Union will implement Aviation Security Legislation EU859/2011 effective 01 February 2012.

The legislation applies to all consignments destined to any European Union country including Qantas ports in the UK and Germany. In order to be compliant with this legislation, Qantas Freight requires customers to ensure the necessary security screening code is captured on the Master Air Waybill in the Handling Information Box and included in any FWB electronically sent to Qantas or one of our Ground Handling Agents.

As a Regulated Agent, all shipments are to be security coded with Security Status "SPX".

Failure to comply with this requirement post 01 February will result in your shipment being subjected to additional security screening and possibly being delayed.
