

FIREARMS AND/OR AMMUNITION TO/OR THROUGH DUBAI ON QANTAS CODESHARE SERVICES AND/OR CONNECTING TO AN EMIRATES FLIGHT IN DUBAI

Dubai authorities require passengers carrying firearms and/or ammunition, travelling to, from or through Dubai to obtain an approval.

To obtain an approval, Emirates now provide an online self-service portal. This can be accessed 24/7 at <http://www.emirates.com/au/english/help/contact-emirates/bgfa/baggage/> .

All Qantas Codeshare passengers (QF8000) and those passengers transferring to an Emirates flight (EK) must obtain an approval before they travel. Firearms and ammunition presented at check-in without the necessary Dubai approval will result in delays and/or denied carriage.

IMPORTANT

Passengers travelling to or from London on QF01/02 and QF09/10 are still required to send their documentation to Qantas Dangerous Goods at dg@qantas.com.au . This will be held on file and, in the unlikely event of a disruption; an approval will be sourced by Qantas ground personnel.

NOTE: Qantas Dangerous Goods no longer process Dubai approval requests.

The United Arab Emirates working week is Sunday to Thursday (closed Friday and Saturday). Passengers should also note there may be a time difference.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- online approval request must be submitted at least **3 working days** before the date of travel;
- ensure you have the corresponding Emirates flight number/s and booking reference/s, this can be obtained from:
 - your travel agent; or
 - Qantas Contact Centres; or
 - Qantas Dangerous Goods dg@qantas.com.au
- documentation:
 - clear scan of your passport;
 - clear scan of your firearms license;
 - export/import permits; and
 - invitation letter (sporting or hunting).

NOTE: An application submitted more than one month ahead of travel will be rejected.

OVERVIEW OF THE ONLINE SELF-SERVICE APPLICATION

- access the Emirates online self-service portal via <http://www.emirates.com/au/english/help/contact-emirates/bgfa/baggage/>
- complete the Firearms, Weapons and Ammunition Declaration Form;
- attach the required supporting documentation (attachment must be less than 5MB) and submit;
- a confirmation 'Firearm Declaration Form' will be emailed.

Once the request has been processed and approved an 'Approval for Carriage of Firearms' will be issued via email.

NOTE: Passengers carrying ammunition on any Qantas Group flight are still required to obtain a Qantas Dangerous Goods Operator Approval (dg@qantas.com.au).
