



## A380 Dallas/Fort Worth – Sydney

### Non-stop A380 services between Dallas/Fort Worth and Sydney

- Customers travelling between Sydney–Dallas/Fort Worth (DFW) will be able to enjoy the luxury of the Qantas A380 from 29 September 2014.
- Qantas will operate six direct return services per week between Sydney and Dallas/Fort Worth (every day except Tuesdays).
- For the first time, customers will be able to experience the luxury of the First cabin on the route.
- The A380 delivers up to 10 per cent improvement in fuel efficiency and carbon emissions per revenue tonne kilometre, than most of today's largest passenger jets.

#### Dallas/Fort Worth

- Qantas began flying to DFW in May 2011.
- Qantas is the only carrier to operate direct services from Australia to Dallas/Fort Worth, offering customers unprecedented access to over 50 onward codeshare destinations in the United States, Canada and Mexico.
- DFW is home to Qantas' **oneworld** partner American Airlines and is less than four hours from every major US city.

#### The Qantas A380

- The Qantas A380 carries 323,000 litres of fuel, equivalent to eight backyard swimming pools.
- The Qantas A380 is fitted with a First, Business, Premium Economy and Economy cabin offering 484 seats, (14 First, 64 Business, 35 Premium Economy and 371 Economy).
- The range of the Qantas A380 is 14,800km.
