It is a requirement that all Qantas.com developments including 3rd party sites be developed to comply with the following 5 standards and guidelines.

1) XHTML 1.0 Transitional - <http://www.w3.org/TR/xhtml1/>

Ensure that all HTML developed is validated against the W3C XHTML 1.0 Transitional document type, you can use the following link to assist you in this:

2) Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.0
